- NSS Units invites the eminent constitutional experts and scholars are invited to deliver guest lectures, providing valuable insights into the historical context and evolution of constitutional values.





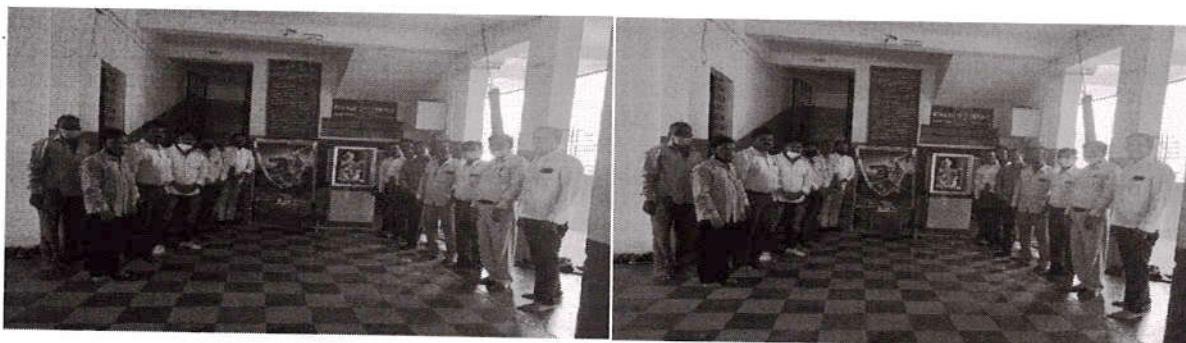
### Workshops:

The Institution conducted “**National Voter’s Day**” on 25-01-2021

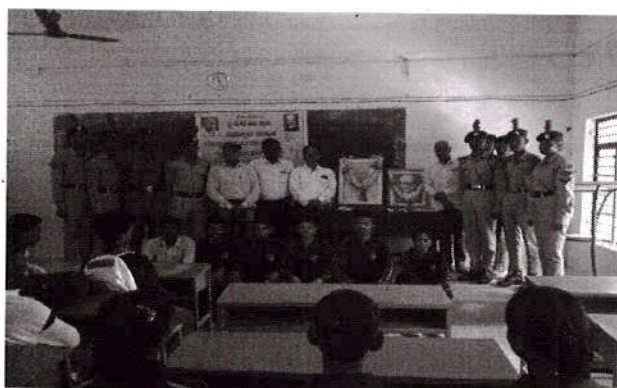
.Oath ceremony around 100 Volunteers and other unit students participated and they took oath to cast their vote without any bias and they will not cast their vote under any influence.
