7.3.1 Portray the performance of the Institution in one area distinctive to its priority and thrust

1. **Large Play Ground:** Institution built 20,000 sqmtr playground for students with provisions for playing outdoor games like cricket, volleyball, Khokho, Kabaddi and Athletics are taken place. It creates team spirit, and encourages a healthy environment. The Institution gives excellent facilities for sports and other entertaining facilities.
2. **Sports Achievements:** The institution regularly conducts Inter-Collegiate & Inter Zonal tournaments. There are 11 students got selected in University Team (**University Blues**). There are **86 University Blue** are selected from the beginning.
3. **Girls Hostel:** The hostel located within the campus and is an integral part of the College. Rooms are furnished with cots, shelves, reading tables, and chairs. The hostel accommodation comprises of rooms which are well furnished, hygienic and have ultra modern amenities. Hostel accommodates with capacity of 60 Girls students.
4. **Campus Drive:** Institution conducts the Campus drive events regularly for providing job opportunities to the students. Institution plays an important role in the placements of students. Institution provides various opportunities and introduces various certificate courses for students to secure their future careers.
5. **Campus Placements/ Skill plus Program by Deshapande Foundation:** The institution conducts Skill plus Program in association with **Deshapande Foundation, Hubli** as skill development programme, employability skills, and education- demand-driven, industry-specific programs. The skill plus Program is a program that helps students prepare for campus placements and careers through training and development.

6. **Units - NSS, NCC, S&G and YRC:**

NSS Units conducts regularly annual special camp in adopted villages. The programme aims to inculcate social welfare of the students, and to provide service to society without prejudice.

NCC Units conducts various training as well as community service extensions activities such as, Tree Plantation Program, Blood Donation, Cleanliness Drive and Health awareness programmes.

Scouts and Guides unit conducts community services such as Jamborees, Rallies, Outreach Programme, Health Checkup Camps and trekking camps.

Youth and Red Cross Unit conducts regularly Blood Donation camps in the campus; it also conducts social and health awareness programmes and encourages the students to extend their humanitarian services to the society.

7. **MoU with 40+ institutions:** Institution focuses on imparting Skill-based training programs to UG students. - Primarily Presentation and communication skills, faculty exchange, industrial visits, special talks, collaborative research, workshop and training
8. **Smart Classrooms:** Institution conducts the smart classrooms boosts confidence of students & encourages them to think beyond imagination. This teaching method is more interactive and collaborative way of learning and many benefits.
9. **Large size & Automated Library:** Library automation is important for libraries to adapt to changing times and serve their patrons more efficiently. Library automation systems help improve library efficiency, increase circulation numbers, save resources and saves the time.
10. **Scholarship:** The Karnataka government provides Scholarship for students. Its goal is to inspire deserving SC, ST, OBC, Minority and Raith Vidhyanidhi (Farmers Children's) students to seek further education. 73 percentage among the total students have been received Govt's Post Metric Scholarships in last five years. The faculty members and alumni of the college announces special cash prizes for meritorious students in every classes. These facilities boost students' academic journey.
11. **Multidimensional Course Combinations.** The multidimensional course involves the cognitive, emotional, and social perspectives taken as analytical lens to examine students' learning and this facilitates in improving higher-order thinking skills.

12. **Strong Mentoring System:** The Institution formed strong mentoring system benefits mentors and mentees, as well as the cell. The purpose of mentoring is to grow by tapping into the knowledge and experience among the students and teachers.
13. **No Ragging and No Tobacco:** The institution organizes the Anti-tobacco awareness programme, The programme states that “No Smoking” motivates students to make healthy lifestyle, these programmes focuses on the negative impacts of smoking and improve the lives without smoking. The institution establishes Anti Ragging cell to monitor any such activities. There was no single Ragging case taken place in the campus.
14. **Republic Day Camp (RDC):** NSS Volunteers are selected for National South Zone Pre-RD Camp regularly. The volunteers are imparted training in leadership development and (March-Past) parade. The RDC Camp provides a boon for the personality development of student. Two NSS volunteers participated at the State Republic Day Parade at Manekshaw Parade Ground in Bangalore in last five years.
15. **Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports Department, GoI Sponsored Survey by NSS.** During the survey NSS volunteers visited about 500 households and interacted with the families to obtain information regarding their educational status, profession and adult Education. Survey by 60 enthusiastic NSS volunteers are witnessed the active participation of under the leadership of Programme officer.
16. **Rejuvenate – The Faculty Festival:** It is generally a three-day programme is organized by the college; Fest conducts the various competitions for Teaching and Non-Teaching faculties. The fest is regularly celebrating in the end of every academic year to reinforce and rejuvenate the faculty members. The Fest conducts the cultural activities rejuvenate the students along with the faculty members.
