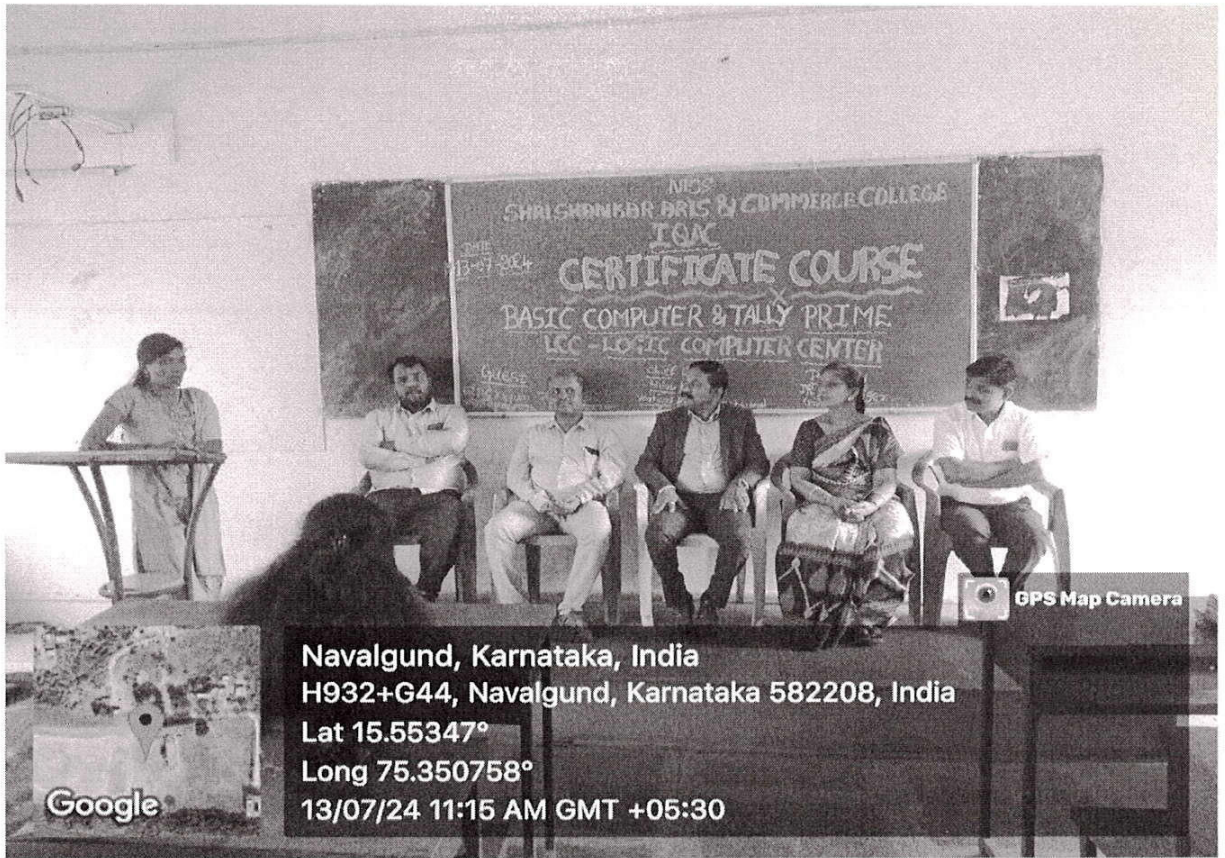

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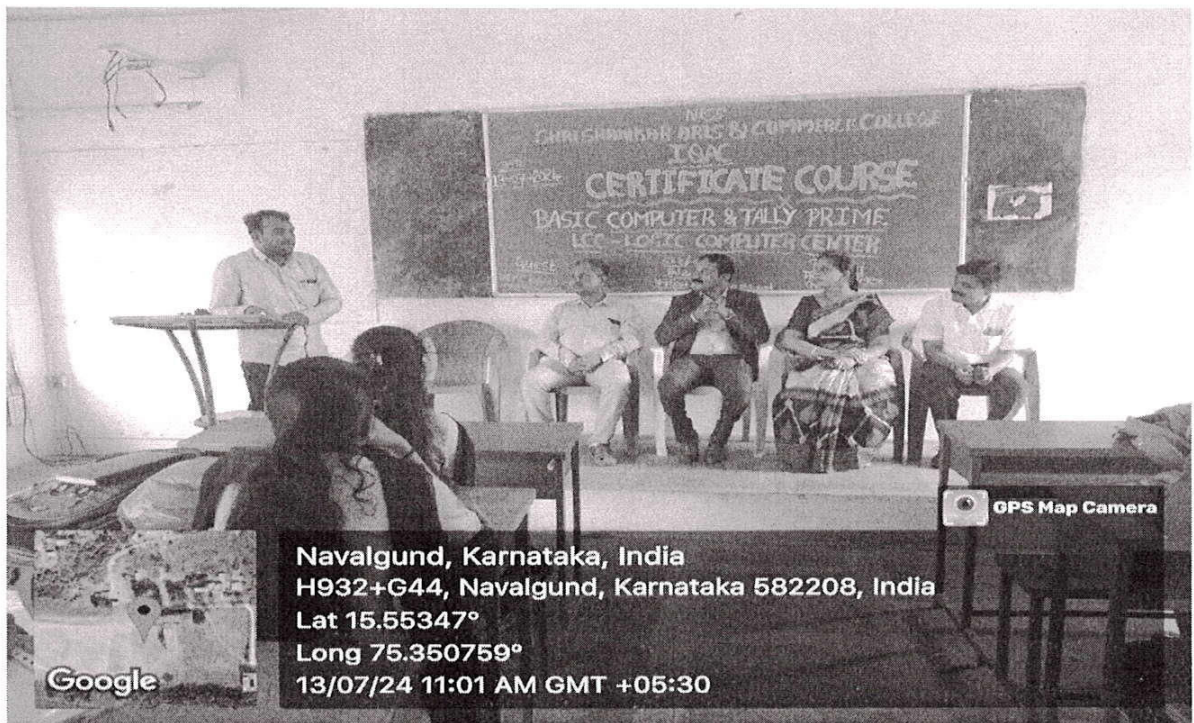

Laws pertaining to copyrights, patents, trademarks, and publicity rights are included in its scope of coverage. One of the most important goals of intellectual property is to foster the production of a wide range of different different types of intellectual commodities. The workshop would centre on national policies regarding innovation and start-ups, namely the National Innovation and Startup Policy (NISIP) for higher education institutions. Furthermore, it will take into account the International Acceleration Program for Startups in the Early Stages of Development..
outcome	Indeed, the Workshop is a platform to encourage participants to think beyond the box and to discover inventions that can be protected. The participants gained an understanding of the fundamentals of IP rights and patent filing, as well as the similarities and differences between various IP protection mechanisms, the statutes, procedures, and case law that support these processes, and how they interact with litigation. How to properly cite digital material and what criteria to apply when doing so are topics that participants consider.

### Workshop



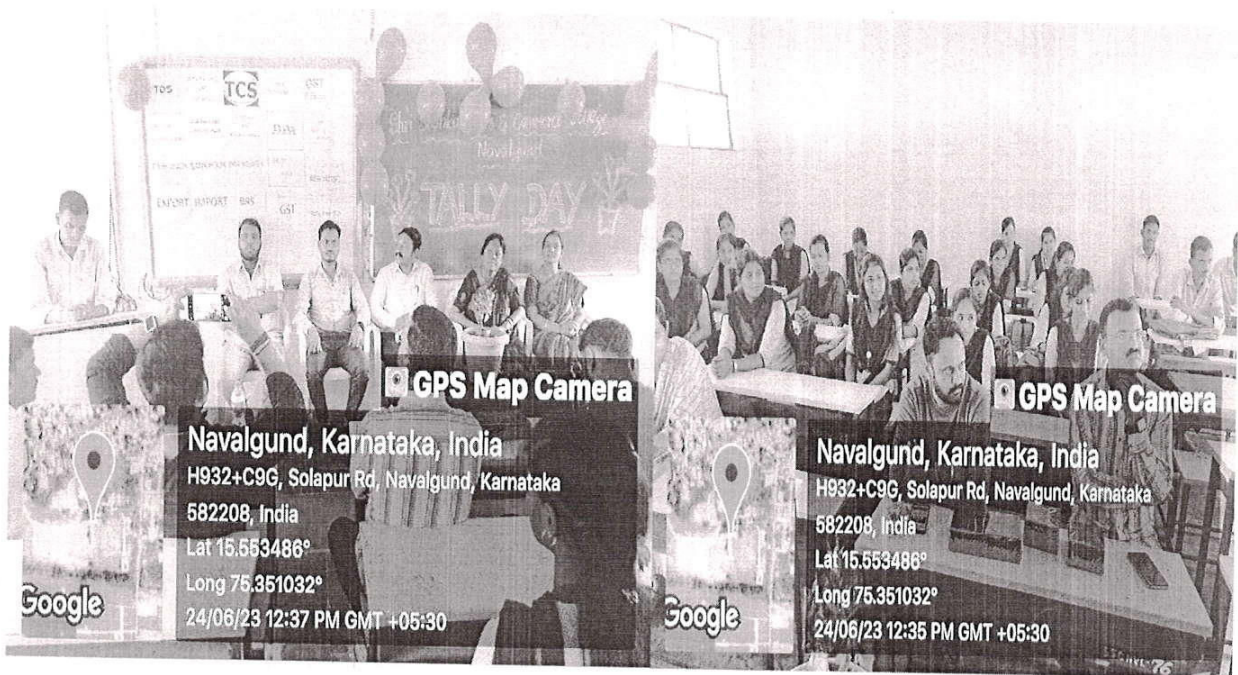

Date	On 1 <sup>st</sup> February 2023
Objective	The goal of this initiative was to educate faculty members and student community about the Digital Content and N-List Consortium's e-journals & e-resources.
Report	<p>The workshop focused on CEC-UGC resources, e-PG pathshala, <a href="http://www.arcives.org">www.arcives.org</a>, DOAJ, ACADEMIA, RESEARCH GATE, E-Prints etc. The "National Library and Information Services Infrastructure for Scholarly Content" (N-LIST) Project provides access to e-resources for students, researchers, and faculty at colleges and other institutions via servers at the INFLIBNET Centre.</p> <p>The approved users from colleges can access e-resources and download articles required by them directly from the publishers' website once they are duly authenticated as authorized users through servers placed at the INFLIBNET Centre. The Project N-LIST provides access to over 6,000 e-journals and 3125000 e-books for students, researchers, and faculty at colleges.</p>
outcome	This curriculum was entirely focused on raising awareness and educating students and faculty on how to find digital content on the internet and through the N-LIST Consortium. The program made it easy for participants to quickly get the academic content they needed. With proper training in seeking information on the N-LIST, faculty members can become more independent in looking for specific information from the N-LIST resources, as well as be motivated to produce research papers.
